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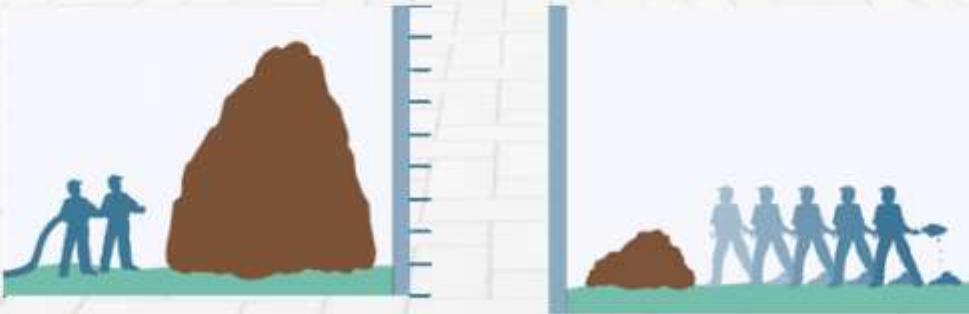

It is also undersized and is "perched" about the streambed, creating a fish passage barrier.. The current culvert is a 6.1-foot wide, 4.6-foot-tall pipe arch culvert and has an estimated capacity of 60 cfs with allowance for debris flow and is about 40 feet long.
